- An IEC teacher is specially trained to teach English to students with additional languages. They have experience teaching in mainstream and other specialised teaching areas.
- Our admin and learning support assistant can help you with enrolment, general questions and works alongside the classroom teachers to provide additional support.

Enrolment at NPIEC

- We enrol students from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds who need intensive English language instruction before entering mainstream ACT schools.
- Students stay in the IEC until they are ready to graduate and then they exit to their mainstream neighbourhood school.
- Children are eligible to come to the IEC if they have no or minimal oral English.
